The amount in this Column 3 reflects the options that will be outstanding following the Exchange.

3. This stock option award was issued pursuant to Deciphera Pharmaceuticals, LLC's 2015 Equity Incentive Plan. The option vests in 16 equal quarterly installments at the end of each quarter following the vesting commencement date of March 1, 2014, subject to continued service through such dates.

4. This stock option award was issued pursuant to Deciphera Pharmaceuticals, LLC's 2015 Equity Incentive Plan. The option vests in 48 equal monthly installments at the end of each month following the vesting commencement date of July 1, 2016, subject to continued service through such dates.

5. This stock option award was issued pursuant to Deciphera Pharmaceuticals, LLC's 2015 Equity Incentive Plan. The option vests in 48 equal monthly installments at the end of each month following the vesting commencement date of May 26, 2017, subject to continued service through such dates.
